

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IX, SECTION 2.91, PARAGRAPH (a) OF THE CHULA VISTA CITY CODE RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NUMBER OF VOTES TO PASS UPON ANY RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Chapter 2, Article IX, Section 2.91, paragraph (a) of the Chula Vista City Code be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:


Sec. 2.91. Board of Appeals and Advisors - Created.

(a) There is hereby created a Board of Appeals and Advisors consisting of seven members who are qualified by experience and training to pass upon matters pertaining to building construction, including therein plumbing and electrical installations. The members of the Board shall be appointed by the Council and shall hold office at the pleasure of the Council pursuant to Section 601 of the Charter. The members shall serve for a term of four (4) years, except that the initial appointment of two (2) members shall be for a term of four (4) years, two (2) members shall be for three (3) years, two (2) members for two (2) years, and one member for one (1) year. Each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified and all vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place has become vacant. The Director of Building and Housing and the Chief of the Fire Department shall be ex officio members of the Board but they shall have no vote. The Director of Building and Housing or his appointed representative shall act as Secretary to the Board. The Board shall select a chairman from its membership annually. Four members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business and the affirmative votes of the majority of the total membership of the Board shall be necessary to pass any recommendations. The Board shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations for conducting its investigations and to govern its meetings and shall render its findings and recommendations in writing to the Director of Building and Housing, with a duplicate to the appellant. All officers and department heads of the City shall cooperate with the Board and render all reasonable assistance to it.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirty-first day from and after its adoption.
