AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ADDING A NEW SECTION 1.7A TO CHAPTER 1 OF THE CHULA VISTA CITY CODE RELATING TO GENERAL PENALTY PROVISIONS

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Chapter 1 of the Chula Vista City Code be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Section 1.7A to read as follows:

Sec. 1.7A. General Penalty Provisions.

Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the City of Chula Vista, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Except in cases where a different punishment is prescribed by any ordinance of the City of Chula Vista, any person convicted of a misdemeanor under the ordinances of the City of Chula Vista shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months or both.

Each such person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of the ordinances of the City of Chula Vista is committed, continued or permitted by any such person, and he shall be punished accordingly.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirty-first day from and after its adoption.
