AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING ARTICLE 6 OF CHAPTER 1 OF THE CHULA VISTA CITY CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 1.636 ESTABLISHING A RANDOM SYSTEM OF LISTING NAMES OF CANDIDATES ON BALLOTS IN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Article 6 of Chapter 1 of the Chula Vista City Code be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Section 1.636 to read as follows:

Sec. 1.636. Random Listing of Candidates' Names on Ballots in Municipal Elections.

The City Clerk, the County Registrar of Voters, or that official responsible for the preparation of ballots for any municipal election in the City of Chula Vista, shall in the listing of candidates for any office undertake by lot or similar method the arrangement of candidates' names on said ballot in a random manner. Neither incumbency nor alphabetical order shall henceforth be used to establish the order of listing of candidates' names on ballots.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirty-first day from and after its adoption.
