

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTIONS 15.24.010, 15.24.015, 15.24.150, 15.24.160, 15.24.180 AND 15.24.250 AND REPEALING SECTIONS 15.24.020, 15.24.060, 15.24.080, 15.24.090, 15.24.100, 15.24.110, 15.24.140, 15.24.190, 15.24.200, 15.24.230, 15.24.250, 15.24.260, 15.24.270, 15.24.280, 15.24.290 AND 15.24.320 OF CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1975 EDITION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Sections 15.24.010, 15.24.015, 15.24.150, 15.24.160, 15.24.180 and 15.24.250 are hereby amended to the Chula Vista Municipal Code to read as follows:

Section 14.25.010. National Electrical Code, 1975 Edition, adopted by reference.

There is hereby adopted by reference that certain document known and designated as the National Electrical Code, 1975 Edition, as published by the National Fire Protection Association, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk. Said document is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Chula Vista, California regulating the installation, repair, operation and maintenance of all electric wiring and electrical apparatus of any nature whatsoever, whether inside or outside of any building, and issuance of permits and providing for the inspection thereof.

Section 15.24.015. Section 210-8(b) Amended. Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters.

The enforcement of Section 210-8(b) to become effective January 1, 1977.

Section 15.24.160. Fess for permits and inspections - Schedule.

A. The fees prescribed in this section shall be paid to the City of Chula Vista for each electrical installation for which a permit is required. For each reinspection trip made necessary by reason of deficient or defective work, a fee of \$10.00 shall be paid to the City of Chula Vista.

B. There shall be a fee of \$2.00 for each permit issued, which fee is not refundable, in addition to the fees set forth in this section.

C. FEE SCHEDULE.

- 1. For issuing each permit\$2.00
- 2. New construction, for each ampere of main service, switch, fuse or breaker25
- 3. New service on existing building, for each ampere of increase in main service, switch, fuse or breaker25
- 4. Remodel, alteration, no change in service, for each ampere of increase25
- 5. Temporary service up to and including 200 amp.....5.00
- 6. Temporary service over 200 amp., per 100 amp.....10.00
- 7. Minimum permit fee..... 3.00

NOTE: Ampere rate shall apply to the secondary side of the transformer or transformers.

Section 15.24.180. Permits - Null and void when - Period of validity - Renewal.

A. Expiration. Every permit issued by the Building Official under the provisions of this code shall expire by limitation and become null and void if the building or work authorized by such permit is not commenced within 120 days of the date of such permit or if the building or work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned at any time after the work is commenced for a period of 120 days. Before such work can be recommenced, a new permit shall be first obtained so to do and the fee therefor shall be one-half the

amount required for a new permit for such work provided no changes have been made or will be made in the original plans and specifications for such work and provided further that such suspension or abandonment has not exceeded one year.

B. Suspension or Revocation. The Building Official may in writing suspend or revoke a permit issued under provisions of this code whenever the permit is issued in error or on the basis of incorrect information supplied or in violation of any ordinance or regulation or any of the provisions of this code.

SECTION II. That Sections 15.24.020, 15.24.060, 15.24.080, 15.24.090, 15.24.100, 15.24.110, 15.24.140, 15.24.190, 15.24.200, 15.24.230, 15.24.250, 15.24.260, 15.24.270, 15.24.280, 15.24.290 and 15.24.320 of the Chula Vista City Code are hereby repealed.
