AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTION 19.30.040 OF CHAPTER 19.30 OF THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE. RELATING TO FREESTANDING SIGNS IN THE C-N ZONE

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning text amendment is categorically exempt from environmental review as a Class II(a) exemption.

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Section 19.30.040, Subsection A.2.a, of Chapter 19.30 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

> Sec. 19.34.040 Sign Regulations.

A.2.a Each neighborhood shopping center or shopping complex, consisting of one parcel or contiguous parcels, shall be allowed one freestanding pole sign, (in existing developed shopping centers a freestanding service station sign shall be allowed to remain and will not be included in determining the total number of signs allowed),

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirty-first day from and after its passage and approval.
