ORDINANCE NO. 1867

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTIONS 10.56.130, 10.56.140, 10.56.150, 10.56.160, REPEALING SECTION 10.56.170, AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 10.62 TO THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARKING VIOLATIONS AND ENFORCEMENT

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION II: That Sections 10.56.130, 10.56.140, 10.56.150 and 10.56.160 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code be, and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 10.56.130 Parking Meter - Overtime.

No person shall permit a vehicle to remain parked in any parking meter zone when the meter shows the parking time has expired.

Sec. 10.56.140 Parking Meter - Extra Time Prohibited.

(a) No person shall permit a vehicle to remain parked beyond the period of legal parking time established for any parking meter zone.

(b) No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited in a parking meter any coins for the purpose of increasing or extending the parking time of any vehicle beyond the legal parking time which has been established for the parking space adjacent to which said parking meter is placed.

Sec. 10.56.150 Parking Meter - Time of Operation.

Said parking meters shall be operated in said parking meter zones every day between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., except Sundays and holidays; provided, however, that whenever the Council of the City of Chula Vista shall by resolution or ordinance provide that the parking time limits shall be effective at other times said parking meters shall be operating during all the times within which the parking time limit shall be effective.

Sec. 10.56.160 Parking Meter - Tampering with.

It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this Chapter for any unauthorized person to deface, injure, tamper with, open or wilfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meters installed under the provisions of this Chapter.

SECTION II: That Section 10.56.170 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION III: That a new Chapter 10.62 be, and the same is hereby added to the Chula Vista Municipal Code to be, and to read as follows:

CHAPTER 10.62 PARKING VIOLATIONS AND ENFORCEMENT.

Sec. 10.62.010 Parking Violations.

(a) Enforcement. Every police officer and every City employee charged with enforcement of the provisions of Chapters 10.52, 10.56 and 10.60 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code relating to illegal parking and time limitations in parking meter zones, the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, and the other laws of the State of California applicable to parking violations within the City of Chula Vista, shall have the duty, when any vehicle is illegally parked, to issue written notice of violation thereof stating the State vehicle license number, make of such vehicle, the time and date of such illegal parking, meter number, street location, and a reference to the appropriate section of the Code and fixing a time and place for appearance by the registered owner to answer said notice. Such notice shall be attached to said vehicle either on the steering post or front door handle thereof or in such other conspicuous place upon the vehicle as to be easily observed by the person in charge of such vehicle upon his return thereto.

(b) Fees. For the purpose of regulating the use of streets:



The owner or operator may mail such payments to the City of Chula Vista's Director of Finance within the time established herein, but shall be responsible for delivery thereof to the office of the Director of Finance.

(c) Failure to Pay. Failure to pay the appropriate fee as provided herein or failure to request a court appearance date to contest the violation will result in either (1) notification of the Department of Motor Vehicles, which agency shall collect the maximum fee established hereby at such time as the owner or operator seeks to reregister his vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Section 4760 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California or (2) in legal proceedings being instituted in the Municipal Court of the South Bay Judicial District against the registered owner for violation of the appropriate Code sections in accordance with the provisions of Section 41102 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on the thirty-first day from and after its approval and shall become operable on July 1, 1979.
