ORDINANCE NO. 1977

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTION 2.56.070 OF CHAPTER 2.56 OF THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE INCREASING THE MANDATORY BID LIMIT TO \$16,000

By unanimous consent at the meeting of March 16, 1982, the City Council placed the ordinance on second reading and adoption. It raises the mandatory bid limit from \$5,000 to \$16,000 in order to take advantage of joint bidding purchases with the school districts.
