

ORDINANCE NO. 1978

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 1947 AUTHORIZING A TWELVE MONTH
CONTINUATION OF SECTION 2.67.025 RELATING TO
THE PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION
IN THE "J" STREET MARINA AREA

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain
as follows:

SECTION I: That Ordinance No. 1947 adding Section
2.67.025 to Chapter 2.67 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code be, and
the same is hereby readopted for a period of twelve months from
the effective date of this ordinance to be, and to read as
follows:

Sec. 2.67.025 Alcoholic Beverage Consumption
 Prohibited in the "J" Street
 Marina Area

It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit
duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to
consume any alcoholic beverage as defined in California
Business and Professions Code, Section 23004, upon any
public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, public park,
beach, restroom, launching ramp, or any other public
areas within the limits of the City of Chula Vista in
that area commonly known as the Chula Vista Launching
Ramp; more particularly described as that area lying
southerly of "G" Street and westerly of Tidelands Avenue
and the southerly prolongation of its north-south axis.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in
full force and effect on the thirty-first day from and after its
adoption.


SECTION III: This ordinance shall be of no further force
and effect twelve (12) months from its effective date unless
renewed by the City Council.


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1947 AUTHORIZING A TWELVE MONTH CONTINUATION OF SECTION 2.67.025 RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION IN THE "J" STREET MARINA AREA

At the City Council meeting of April 27, 1982, the Council placed on second reading and adoption ordinance #1978 adding Section 2.67.025 to Chapter 2.67 of the Municipal Code making it unlawful for any person without a permit issued by the City Manager to consume any alcoholic beverage in the area of the "J" Street Marina, more particularly described as that area lying southerly of "G" Street and westerly of Tidelands Avenue and the southerly prolongation of its north-south axis.
