

ORDINANCE NO. 2204

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ADDING
CHAPTER 9.09 TO THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE
RELATING TO LOITERING

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby
ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Chapter 9.09 is hereby added to the
Chula Vista Municipal Code to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9.09 LOITERING.

Sec. 9.09.010 Prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person to loiter in a public
place in such a manner as to maliciously:

- A. Create or cause to be created a danger of a breach
of the peace;
- B. Create or cause to be created any disturbance or
annoyance to the comfort and repose of any persons;
- C. Obstruct the free passage of pedestrians or
vehicles;
- D. Obstruct, molest or interfere with any person
lawfully in any public place.

Sec. 9.09.020 Defined.

As used in this section, "loitering" shall mean
remaining idle in essentially one location and shall
include the concepts of spending time idly, loafing, or
walking about aimlessly, including the colloquial
expression "hanging around", and shall include the
making of unsolicited remarks of an offensive,
disgusting, or insulting nature or which are calculated
to annoy or disturb the person to, or in whose hearing,
they are made.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in
full force on the thirty-first day from and after its adoption.
