## ORDINANCE NO. 2442

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTION 2.04.150 OF THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE CONSENT CALENDAR FOR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That Section 2.04.150 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2.04.150 Consent calendar.

- Items for inclusion on the agenda, which have been reviewed by the Α. city manager and staff and determined to not require special Council consideration, mailed to the council for study and which are made available to the public prior to and at council meetings, shall be grouped together for action by the city council. recommendations on the action to be taken for said items shall be indicated in a concise and summary form. These matters shall be listed under what is to be known as the "consent calendar" in the order of business as indicated in Section 2.04.140. the consent calendar may be made by a simple motion approved by the city council; provided, however, that the presiding officer shall first advise the audience that the consent calendar matters will be so adopted, in toto, by one action of the council unless any council member or any individual or organization interested in one or more consent calendar items has any question or wishes to make a statement relative to such an item. In that event, the presiding officer may defer action on the particular matter or matters and place the same on the agenda for consideration in such order as he deems appropriate.
- B. It is understood that the motion for approval of items on the consent calendar encompasses therein a waiver of the requirement of reading of the text of ordinances and resolutions contained therein at a direction that the reading of the text be waived and that the heading only be read, and in the case of ordinances, that such ordinance be placed on second reading and adopted.
- C. The written agenda available to the public and to the city council shall provide the following notice of explanation to the public concerning the consent calendar:

"All matters listed under CONSENT CALENDAR will be enacted by one motion in the form listed below. There will be no separate discussion of these items prior to the time the Council votes on the motion unless members of the Council, staff, or the public request specific items to be discussed and/or removed from the Consent

Calendar for separate action. Members of the public who wish to discuss a Consent Calendar item should come forward to the lectern upon invitation by the Mayor, state their name, address and Consent Calender item number."

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirtieth day from and after its adoption.
