

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 220 OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, Entitled "An ordinance amending an ordinance numbered 163, passed, adopted, and approved on March 8, 1927, entitled: 'An Ordinance of the City of Chula Vista, California, providing for the creation in said City of Five (5) Zones, consisting of various Districts and prescribing the classes of buildings, structures and improvements in said several zones, and the uses thereof; defining the terms used therein, prescribing the penalty for the violation of the provisions thereof and repealing any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith,' and for other purposes and declaring an emergency." BY INCLUDING IN 'D' ZONE THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN 'E' ZONE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 220 of the City of Chula Vista, California, be and the same is hereby amended as follows: All that property in 'E' Zone as described in the last paragraph of said Section be and the same is hereby ~~removed from said 'E' Zone~~ removed from said 'E' Zone and added to and included in 'D' Zone.

Section 2. All the provisions of Section 8 of Ordinance No. 163 of said City are hereby made applicable to the property described in Section 1 herein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 31st day after its final passage and approval.
