AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SECTION 10.64.030 OF THE CHULA VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXEMPT CHULA VISTA CITY VEHICLES FROM DRIVING ONLY ON TRUCK ROUTES

The city council of the City of Chula Vista does hereby ordain as follows:


Section 10.64.030 of the Chula Vista Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.64.030 Exemptions, City of Chula Vista, Public utility, solid waste and contractors' vehicles.


The provisions of this chapter shall not be applicable to any vehicle owned by the City of Chula Vista, a public utility or a licensed contractor while necessarily in use in the construction, installation, repair, or maintenance of any public facility or utility, to any vehicle subject to the provisions of sections 1031 through 1036, inclusive, of the California Public Utilities Code or to any vehicle used for the collection and transportation of garbage and solid waste.


