ORDINANCE NO. 437

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING PORTIONS OF CERTAIN ALLEYS AS ONE-WAY ALLEYS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following described alleys in the City of Chula Vista are hereby designated and established as one-way alleys:

- a). The alley located between Third Avenue and
 Landis Avenue from "E" Street to Center Street
 in which the traffic shall move only in a
 Northerly direction.
- b). The alley located between Third Avenue and Madrona Church Avenue from "E" Street to/Q=NEER Street in which the traffic shall move only in a Southerly direction.

SECTION 2. The City Engineer shall cause signs indicating the direction of lawful traffic movement in the above alleys at vevery intersection of such alleys with another public street or highway in the City of Chula Vista.

SECTION 3. When signs are erected in such one-way alleys giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle in a direction contrary to the direction indicated on such signs and designated in this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than FIVE HUNDRED (\$500) DOLLARS or by imprisonment of not exceeding three (3) months, or by both such

fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective and be in force thirty-one days after the final passage thereof, and shall, within fifteen (15) days after its final passage, be published once in the Chula Vista Star, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Chula Vista, California.
