Original Resolution Missing

Excerpt from minutes of Board of Trustees Meeting of January 7, 1913

The following Resolution was introduced: "Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista that the Sweetwater Water Company, of Maine, be and the same is hereby requested to furnish to said Board during the month of January, 1913, a detailed statement, verified by the oath of the president and secretary of such corporation, showing the name of each water rate payer, his or her place of residence, and the amount paid for water by each of such water-rate payers, during the year preceeding the date of such statement, and also showing all revenue derived from all sources, and an itemized statement of expenditures made for supplying water during said time; also a statement showing the amount of money actually expended annually, since commencing business, in the purchase, construction, and maintenance, respectively, of the property necessary to the carrying on of its business, and also the gross cash receipts annually, for the same period, from all sources; and that said Company be and the same is hereby notified that at the next regular meeting of this Board, to be held on Tuesday, the 4th day of February, 1913, this Board will meet at the City Hall, in the City of Chula Vista, at seven o'clock p.m., to consider the matter of fixing water rates for the ensuing year; and said Company is hereby notified and respectfully requested to appear by its officers or representatives before the said Board at said time and place, and offer and present any evidence or proofs that it may desire relative to the operation and maintenance of said water system; and that at said time and place said Company will be given full opportunity to be heard on all matters affecting the fixing of such water rates. On motion, duly seconded, said Resolution was adopted; all voting aye.
