Excerpt from minutes of Board of Trustees Meeting of

May 20, 1913

Upon motion, duly seconded, the following Resolution was adopted:

Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista, that whereas, they propose to call a bond election for the purpose of improving the streets of said city, and among others desire to put to grade and surface with granite Third Avenue, and that portion of "E" Street and Fourth Avenue traversed by the electric car line; and whereas the citizens of Chula Vista very much desire that a county road be laid south from the southerly limits of said city at Third Avenue to Otay along the electric car line, connecting with the road to be laid out to Tia Juana; and whereas, in the opinion of this Board the laying out of such road would tend to give additional support to the proposition of bonding the city for the improvement of its streets as aforesaid;

Now, therefore, we earnestly urge upon our Supervisor, the Hon. C. H. Swallow, to use every endeavor to procure the laying out of such road to Otay, and that steps may be taken immediately to that end.
