

RESOLUTION NO. 146

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista, California :

That, in consideration of the granting by Tracy Brick and Art Stone Company to the City of Chula Vista, California, a municipal corporation of the 6th class, in the County of San Diego, State of California, the right, privilege, franchise and easement, forever, to construct, excavate for, lay, use, maintain and repair, a SEWER, and all pipes and material usual and necessary therefor on the Southernly 16 feet of the Easterly 682 feet of the Southernly 332 feet of the South East Quarter of Section 172, Rancho de la Nacion in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, according to map thereof No. 505, filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County, March, 13, 1888, said CITY OF CHULA VISTA does hereby agree and obligate itself to replace all fences on said property which it may remove in the construction of said sewer, in a good and proper condition upon the property line of said property and to restore the ground where said sewer is constructed to the same condition that the same is now, and reconstruct the roadway now existing thereon so that same will be in as good condition as at the present time, all of the aforesaid to be done promptly after said sewer improvement will permit of same and at said City of Chula Vista's <sup>own</sup> expense.
