

Whereas, It has been represented to the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista California by the constituted authority of the Federal Government that the dredging of the Lower Bay of San Diego, California should be done by the co-operation of the cities upon such Bay and the Federal Government financially and otherwise and such Board of Trustees fully <sup>realizing and</sup> agreeing such to be the case and <sup>being</sup> most heartily in favor thereof,

Therefore Be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista California that we hereby Pledge said City through its said Board of Trustees to fully co-operate in the carrying out of said project in all possible ways within the power of said City including such financial assistance by said City as shall be appropriate and commensurate with its ability so to do and urge that said project may be commenced and carried to completion at the earliest possible time. Said Board of Trustees will do all in their power to furnish their proper share in conjunction with national City California of the Ten Thousand Dollars deemed proper for them to supply and more if necessary to the success of said project.
