

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

No. 169

MADISON AVENUE--NATIONAL AVENUE--E STREET--CHURCH AVENUE
AND DEL MAR AVENUE

RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista, California, to order the following work to be done and improvement to be made in said City, and that the same is for the public interest, to-wit: The construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between the southerly line of D Street and a line 50 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the return at the southwest corner of D Street and Madison Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between a line 150 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street and a line 200 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalks and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between a line 194.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street and a line 344.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between the northerly line of Flower Street and a line 144.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the return at the northwest corner of Flower Street and Madison Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between the northerly line of Flower Street and a line 144.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the return at the northeast corner of Flower Street and Madison Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between a line 194.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street and a line 244.6 feet northerly from the northerly line of Flower Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between a line 300 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street and a line 250 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of Madison Avenue, in said City, between the southerly line of D Street and a line 200 feet southerly from the southerly line of D Street, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the return at the southeast corner of D Street and Madison Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of National Avenue, in said City, between a line 458 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street and a line 624 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of National Avenue, in said City, between the northerly line of E Street and a line 146 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street, also cement concrete sidewalk

and cement concrete curbing in the return at the northwest corner of E Street and National Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of National Avenue, in said City, between the northerly line of E Street and a line 100 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of National Avenue, in said City, between a line 150 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street and a line 292.35 feet northerly from the northerly line of E Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of National Avenue, in said City, between a line 200 feet southerly from the southerly line of Flower Street and a line 250 feet southerly from the southerly line of Flower Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of National Avenue, in said City, between the northerly line of Flower Street and the southerly line of D Street, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the returns at the northeast corner of Flower Street and National Avenue, and the southeast corner of D Street and National Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the southerly side of E Street, in said City, between the westerly line of Church Avenue and the easterly line of the alley between Church Avenue and Third Avenue, also cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing in the returns at the southwest corner of Church Avenue and E Street, and the Southeast corner of E Street and the alley between Church Avenue and Third Avenue.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Church Avenue, in said City, between the southerly line of E Street and a line 50 feet southerly from the southerly line of E Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the westerly side of Church Avenue, in said City, between a line 290.5 feet southerly from the southerly line of E Street and a line 390.5 feet southerly from the southerly line of E Street.

Also, the construction of cement concrete sidewalk and cement concrete curbing on the easterly side of Del Mar Avenue, in said City, between a line 120.4 feet southerly from the southerly line of Davidson Street and a line 170.4 feet southerly from the southerly line of Davidson Street.

All of said work hereinbefore generally described shall be constructed in the manner of the locations, within the limits, of the materials, and of the dimensions
All of said work hereinbefore generally described shall be as shown upon and according to the plans, drawings, typical cross-sections and specifications therefor contained in Document No. 138 on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and copies of which are on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, heretofore approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of said City as the plans, drawings, typical cross-sections and specifications, and by reference hereto to be followed in making said improvement, and by reference thereto all said plans, drawings, typical cross-sections and specifications are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

The said Board of Trustees hereby determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment of twenty-five dollars or more remaining unpaid after the full expiration of twenty days from the date of the warrant, to represent the expense of said work and improvement, said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the fifteenth day of the next

November following their date and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January every year after the fifteenth day of the next November following their date until the whole is paid. Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, interest payable semi-annually by coupon on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said bonds shall be issued and the principal and interest thereof shall be paid under and in pursuance of the "Improvement Act of 1911," and amendments thereto.

That the contemplated work and improvement mentioned is in the opinion of said Board of Trustees of more than local and ordinary public benefit and the expenses of such work and improvement are made chargeable upon the district hereinafter described, and said Board of Trustees does hereby declare said district to be the district benefited by said work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof. Said district is described as follows, to-wit: All that real property in the said City of Chula Vista included within the exterior boundary lines of said district as shown upon that certain plat No. 317, indicating the exterior boundary lines of such district, which plat, approved by the said Board of Trustees, is on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City; excepting therefrom all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to said plat for a particular description of such district.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on the 23rd day of November 1926 at 7:30 o'clock P.M., in the Council Chamber of the ~~City of~~ said Board of Trustees in the City Hall of said City, in the City of Chula Vista, State of California, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board of Trustees and show cause why said proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

That the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby directed to cause this resolution of intention to be published twice in the Chula Vista Star, a weekly newspaper, published and circulated generally in said City, and hereby designated for that purpose by the said Board of Trustees, ~~there being no daily newspaper published in said city of Chula Vista.~~

That the Street Superintendent of said City shall after the adoption of this resolution of intention, cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of said contemplated work or improvement, at not more than three hundred feet in distance apart, but not less than three in all notices of the passage of this resolution of intention, and when the work to be done is only upon an entire crossing or intersection, or any part thereof, he shall cause such notices to be conspicuously posted in front of each quarter block or irregular block liable to be assessed, and when work is chargeable upon a district, he shall cause such notices to be conspicuously posted upon all open streets within such district, at not more than three hundred feet in distance apart on each street so posted, all in the time, form and manner required by law; and thereupon said Superintendent of ~~Six~~ Streets shall cause to be filed in the office of the City Clerk of said City, an affidavit showing the posting of said notices of improvement.

The said Board of Trustees does not deem it advisable that the City Clerk of said City mail copies of the Notice of Improvement to owners or reputed owners, and he is not required to mail same.

All of the herein proposed work shall be done in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, designated as the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7th, 1911, and amendments thereto.
