

RESOLUTION 170.

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, that the Deed, dated October 4, 1926, executed by the Chula Vista, Citrus Association, granting to the said City of Chula Vista, for street purposes, the following described real estate:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Second Avenue, with the Northerly line of Lot 24, $\frac{1}{4}$ -Section 187, of Chula Vista, according to Map thereof, No. 505, filed in the office of the County Recorder of the said San Diego County, March 13, 1888; thence North 71° East, forty feet to the true place of beginning, which is the Northwesterly corner of said Lot 24; thence North 71° deg. East, along the Northerly line of said Lot 24, 242.9 feet, to a point; thence South $54^{\circ} 6\frac{1}{2}'$ East 36.67 feet to a point; thence South 71° West parallel with the Northerly line of said Lot 24, and 30 feet therefrom, 264 feet; thence North 19° West, 30 feet to the place of beginning,

The granting and dedicating to said City, for street purposes, the said real estate described above, is hereby accepted; and said grant and dedication of such real estate for such purposes, is approved and accepted by said City of Chula Vista, and its Board of Trustees.
