

RESOLUTION NO. 17003

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AMENDING SCHEDULE III, SECTION 10.52.280 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE - PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS - MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, in order to minimize traffic hazards and congestion, and for the purpose of the promotion of public safety parking prohibitions on Main Street should be authorized by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, a review of trial traffic regulations initiated by the City Engineer under the authority of the Municipal Code show that these regulations are operating effectively and should be made permanent; and,

WHEREAS, the Safety Commission, at their meeting of June 11, 1992, voted unanimously to accept staff's recommendation and recommend that the City Council approve a resolution prohibiting parking along the north curb line on Main Street fronting the Woodland Park Subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista does amend Schedule III, Section 10.52.280 of the Municipal Code - Parking Prohibited at all times on certain streets as follows:

Schedule III - Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets

Main Street	A point approx. 110' west of the centerline of Otay Valley Road	A point approx. 500' west of the beginning point	North


