

RESOLUTION NO. 13

WHEREAS, by its Resolution of Intention duly passed and adopted on the 16th day of June, 1927, it was resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Chula Vista, California, that the public interest and convenience required the following public work to be done in said City; and said Board of Trustees did by said Resolution of Intention declare its intention to order the following public work in said City, to wit: The closing up and vacating of all that portion of "Country Club Drive", in said City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point where the center line of L Street intersects the Westerly line of "Country Club Drive"; thence South 4 degrees 54 minutes East along said Westerly line 41.13 feet to the Southerly line of L Street; thence North 71 degrees 38 minutes East along the Southerly line of L Street 90.0 feet; thence North 81 degrees 55 minutes West 89.82 feet to the place of beginning; being a triangular piece of land situate on the Northerly side of Lot 19, Quarter Section 12 of Chula Vista, California, according to map thereof No. 505, filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County, March 13th, 1888, said "Country Club Drive" being a Street in said City of Chula Vista.

AND WHEREAS, notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention have been duly posted by the Street Superintendent of said City of Chula Vista, in the way and manner provided by law, as appears by his affidavit thereof on file with the City Clerk of said City and the notice required by law relating thereto has been duly published, in the manner and for the requisite time required by law, as appears by the affidavit of the publisher of the paper in which same was so printed, on file with said Clerk, and no objections having been made or filed as required by law, or otherwise, in opposition to the closing and vacating of said portion of said "Country Club Drive", and more than ten days having elapsed since the last publication of said notice, and all proceedings required by law with reference to the ~~existing~~ closing up and vacating of said portion of said "Country Club Drive", having been duly taken and complied with and the said Board of Trustees having acquired jurisdiction to order the closing up and vacating of said portion of said "Country Club Drive" and there being no assessment necessary or required for the cost and expense of the same.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, that all that portion of "Country Club Drive", ~~existing~~ a public street, in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, described as follows, towit: Beginning at a point where the center line of L Street, in said City, intersects the Westerly line of "Country Club Drive"; thence South 4 degrees 54 minutes East along said Westerly line 41.13 feet to the Southerly line of said L Street; thence North 71 degrees 38 minutes East along the Southerly line of said L Street 90.0 feet; thence North 81 degrees 55 minutes ~~East~~ West 89.82 feet to the place of beginning; and the same is hereby closed up and vacated, as such portion of said "Country Club Drive" in all respects and the same and all thereof, so described, is hereby and by this Resolution and Order abandoned, closed up and vacated, and no claim thereto as said portion of "Country Club Drive" exists or is made by said City of Chula Vista, as a ~~new~~ portion of said street.
