RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 202

RELATING TO A PORTION OF FIFTH AVENUE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the closing up and vacating of that portion of Fifth Avenue in said City hereinafter described; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said Board of Trustees and City Council to order the closing up and vacating of that portion of Fifth Avenue in said City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California in Quarter Section 125 according to map No. 505 of Chula Vista, between the South line of the North half of said Quarter Section 125 and a point 390.24 feet Southerly from said South line; more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Quarter Section 125 thence <sup>South</sup> North 71° 03' West 25 feet, thence South 18° 19' East 354.70 feet, thence along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 17.2 feet bearing South 71° 21' West 12.0 feet to a point, thence ~~then~~ South 68° 39' East 70.53 feet, thence North 18° 39' West 411.35 feet, thence South 71° 03' West 25 feet to the place of beginning. That the exterior boundaries of the district of lands of said City to be effected by said work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses.

hereof, are described as follows, to wit: *the description last above given are such exterior boundaries of said district of lands of said City to be so effected by said work and improvement and to be so assessed excepting all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways.*

That no assessment is necessary or will be made upon said land or otherwise to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, *and no land is to be taken therefor* that the Chula Vista Star, a weekly newspaper published and having a general circulation in said City of Chula Vista, be and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Superintendent of Streets of said City shall cause to be published in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and he shall cause the same to be so published and said Superintendent of Streets shall cause to be ~~put~~ posted notices of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and proposed public work and improvement in the manner, form and for the time required by law and said publication of said notice in said newspaper shall be for a period of four

successive weeks.
