RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHULA VISTA APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO EXTEND
THE ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA AND THE CHULA
VISTA POLICE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, in February 2019, the Chula Vista Police Officer's Association (CVPOA) approached the City requesting the City implement a Workers' Compensation Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) for claims made by the City's sworn police personnel; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, Council approved and authorized the addition of 0.50 full-time equivalent (FTE) in the Human Resources Department to develop, implement, and administer the ADR pilot program; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2020, the City Council adopted a Memorandum of Understanding with the CVPOA and approved the ADR Agreement, establishing an ADR pilot program for one year; and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2022, the City Council adopted the First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the CVPOA and approved the extension of the ADR Agreement to January 12, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the CVPOA and approved the extension of the ADR agreement to January 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting approval of an amendment to the agreement to extend the program for an additional year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves a third amendment to the Alternative Dispute Resolution agreement between the City of Chula Vista and the Chula Vista Police Officer's Association for an additional year to January 12, 2025 and authorizes and directs the City Manager or their designee to execute the Third Amendment, in the form presented, with such minor modifications that may be approved by the City Manager and City Attorney.




