

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 776

K Street, Sixth Avenue and San Miguel Drive.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, in the County of San Diego, State of California, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the closing up of a portion of the streets hereinafter mentioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said City Council to order the closing up of those portions of K STREET, SIXTH AVENUE AND SAN MIGUEL DRIVE, in said City of Chula Vista, California, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly line of K Street with the northeasterly line of Vista Way, as the same is dedicated in Block A, Country Club Villas; thence northwesterly along the northwesterly production of the northeasterly line of said Vista Way to an intersection with the northerly line of K Street; thence easterly along the northerly line of said K Street, and the easterly production thereof, to an intersection with the center line of Sixth Avenue; thence southerly along the center line of said Sixth Avenue a distance of 415.09 feet to a point; thence N. 70° 12' W. to the intersection of the northeasterly line of said Vista Way with the northerly line of San Miguel Drive; thence easterly along the northerly line of said San Miguel Drive to an intersection with the westerly line of Sixth Avenue; thence northerly along the westerly line of said Sixth Avenue to an intersection with the southerly line of K Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of said K Street to the point of beginning.

That it is not deemed necessary that any land be taken therefor.

That the exterior boundaries of the district of lands in said City to be affected by said work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Sixth Avenue which is intersected by the southeasterly production of the northeasterly line of Vista Way, as the same is dedicated in Block A, Country Club Villas; thence northwesterly along the southeasterly production of the northeasterly line of said Vista Way, and along the northeasterly line of said Vista Way, and along the northwesterly production of the northwesterly line of said Vista Way to an intersection with a line parallel to and distant 100 feet northerly from the northerly line of K Street; thence easterly along a line parallel to and distant 100 feet northerly from the northerly line of said K Street, and the easterly production thereof, to an intersection

with the center line of Sixth Avenue; thence southerly along the center line of said Sixth Avenue to the point of beginning; excepting therefrom all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways.

That the CHULA VISTA STAR, a weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City of Chula Vista, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law, and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper by four successive insertions therein, there being no daily newspaper published and circulated in said City.

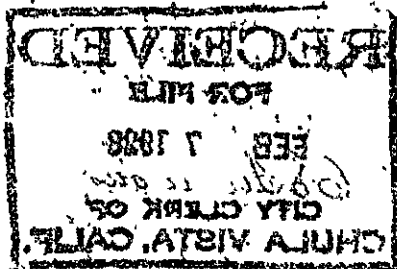
