RESOLUTION No. 231

## RESOLUTION ORDERING THE WORK

Whereas the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California did on the 7th. day of February, 1928, pass its Resolution of Intention No. 225 to order the hereinafter described work to be done and improvement to be made in said City which Resolution of Intention was duly and legally published as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of *Leafy R. Crooks* now on file in the office of the clerk of said City; and whereas, notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention No. 225 headed "Notice of Improvement" were duly and legally posted along the line of said contemplated work and improvement and in front of all the property liable to be assessed therefor, and on and along each and every open street and highway in the assessment district described in said Resolution of Intention, in time, form, manner and number as required by law, after the passage of said Resolution of Intention, as appears from the affidavit of *J. H. Schraeder*, who personally posted the same, and who, upon the completion of the posting of said notices, forthwith filed said affidavit in the office of the City clerk, making oath that he completed the posting of said notices on the 16th day of February, 1928; and whereas,\*

no protests or objections have been presented in the time, form and manner as required by law, and said City Council having now acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvement, it is hereby.

RESOLVED, that the public interest and convenience require the work herein described and the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California hereby orders the following work to be done and improvement to be made in said City, to-wit: The construction of cement concrete sidewalks and cement concrete curbing on portions of Flower Street, portions of First Avenue and portions of Cedar Avenue in the City of Chula Vista, California. For a description of said Work and Improvement and of the Assessment District to be benefited, effected and assessed to pay for the same, reference is hereby made to the Resolution of Intention No. 225 passed and adopted by the City Council of said City on the 7th. day of February, 1928 and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City.

The City Clerk is hereby instructed to post a notice of said work, together with the plans and specifications therefor, conspicuously for five days on or near the council chamber door, of said City / <sup>Council</sup> inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing the work ordered. Said clerk is also directed to publish twice, a notice inviting such proposals, and referring to the specifications posted or on file, in the "Chula Vista Star" a weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City and hereby designated for that purpose.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Chula Vista certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Said sealed proposals or bids shall be delivered to the clerk of the City Council of said City, on or before 7:30 o'clock P. M., on ~~3rd~~ Tuesday the 3rd day of April, 1928, said time being not less than ten days from the time of the first posting and publication of the notice of said work and inviting sealed proposals, on which day and hour all proposals or bids will be publicly opened by said City Council of said City.

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista at a regular meeting thereof held, Tuesday, March, 6th, 1928.

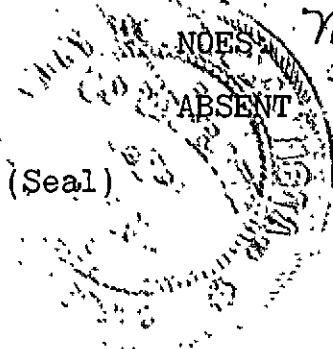
