RESOLUTION DIRECTING WORK TO BE DONE
UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE City ENGINEER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California did on the 5th day of February, 1928, pass a resolution ordering certain work and improvements in pursuance of proceedings taken under the "Improvement Act of 1911" and which are described in Resolution of Intention No. 225 passed February, 7th., 1928, reference to which resolution is hereby expressly made for further particulars;

And whereas said City Council desires that said work and improvement be done under the direction of the City Engineer, now therefore The City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California hereby resolve and direct that the aforesaid work and improvement shall be done under the direction of the City Engineer and that the materials used shall comply with the specifications and be to the satisfaction of the City Engineer instead of the Superintendent of Streets of said City.

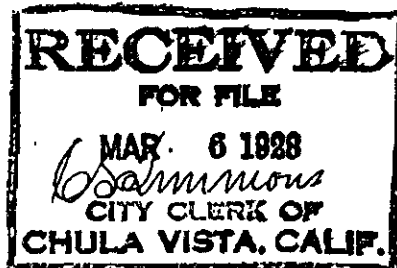
