RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT TO BE
MADE AND SIGNED BY THE *City* ENGINEER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California,
did on the 6th. day of March, 1928, pass a Resolution ordering
certain work and improvements to be made in pursuance of proceedings
taken under the "Improvement Act of 1911" and which are described in
resolution of intention No. 225, passed February, 7th., 1928,
reference to which resolution is hereby expressly made for further
particulars;
