RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, as follows:

That the deed, dated April 16, 1928, executed and delivered by Bank of Italy National Trust and Savings Association, a National Banking Association, grantor, to the City of Chula Vista, California, grantee, for street purposes, of the property described as follows:

All that portion of ~~1/4~~-Section 171, Rancho de la Nacion, according to map thereof, No. 166, on file in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, State of California, viz:

The North 20 feet of said ~~1/4~~-Section, excepting therefrom the East 20 feet thereof, and that portion of said land on which building of R. & H. Tyce now stands, being a tract two feet by 75 feet, to be used for street purposes,

Is hereby approved and accepted by the City Council of said City of Chula Vista, for and on behalf of said City of Chula Vista, for street purposes, and as a dedication thereof for such purposes, and as a part of G Street in fact and in name, is hereby declared to be a part of said G Street in said City of Chula Vista, in fact and in name.
