

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 245

Alley between Flower Street and E Street  
in Block 1 Brightwood Subdivision.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Chula Vista in the County of San Diego, State of California, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the closing up of the Alley in Block 1, Brightwood Subdivision, <sup>running Northerly and Southerly</sup> between the Southerly line of Flower Street and the Northerly line of E Street in said City and hereinafter mentioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said City Council to order the closing up of the said Alley in Block 1, Brightwood Sub-<sup>running Northerly and Southerly</sup> division, between the Southerly line of Flower Street and the Northerly line of E Street in said City of Chula Vista, California.

That it is not deemed necessary that any land be taken therefor. That the exterior boundaries of the District of lands in said City to be affected by said work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows:

Beginning at the North West corner of Block 1, Brightwood Subdi-  
vision; thence Easterly along the Northwesterly line of said Block to  
the <sup>N</sup>ortheasterly corner thereof; thence Southeasterly along the North-  
easterly line of said Block 1 to the Southeasterly corner thereof;  
thence Southwesterly along the Southeasterly line of said Block 1 to the  
Southwesterly corner thereof; thence Northwesterly along the Southwest-  
erly line of said Block 1 to the point of beginning; excepting therefrom  
all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways, *all in the City of Chula  
Vista California*

That THE CHULA VISTA STAR, a weekly newspaper published and circu-  
lated and of general circulation in the said City of Chula Vista, be and  
it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superinten-  
dent of said City shall cause to be published in the manner and form  
required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and  
the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the  
passage of this Resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by  
law, and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said  
newspaper by four successive insertions therein, according to law, there  
being no daily newspaper published and circulated in said city.

Passed, adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California this 5th day of June, 1928, by the following vote, to-wit;
