RESOLUTION ORDERING THE CLOSING UP OF THE  
ALLEY BETWEEN FLOWER STREET AND E STREET IN BLOCK  
I, BRIGHTWOODS SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF CHULA  
VISTA, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, by its Resolution of Intention duly passed and adopted on the 6th. day of June, 1928, it was resolved by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, in the County of San Diego, State of California, that the public interest and convenience of said City required the following public work to be done in said City; and said Council did by its Resolution of Intention declare its intention to order the following public work in said City, to-wit:

The closing up of the Alley in Block 1, Brightwoods Subdivision running northerly and southerly in the City of Chula Vista, California between the southerly line of Flower Street and the northerly line of E Street in said City of Chula Vista, California.

AND WHEREAS, notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention have been duly posted by the Street Superintendent of said City of Chula Vista, in the way and manner provided by law and the notice required by law relating thereto has been duly published in the manner and for the requisite length of time required by law, and no objections having been made and filed as required by law or otherwise in opposition to the closing up of aforesaid alley, and more than ten days having elapsed since the last publication of said notices and all proceedings required by law with reference to the closing up of said alley having been duly taken and complied with and the City Council having acquired jurisdiction to order the closing up of said alley and there being no assessments necessary or required for the cost and expense of the same,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, that the alley in Block one Brightwoods Subdivision running northerly and southerly in the City of Chula Vista, California, between the southerly line of Flower Street and the northerly line of E Street in said City of Chula Vista be and is hereby closed up.

Passed, adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, this 4th day of September, 1928 by the following vote, to-wit:
