

RESOLUTION No. 254.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, as follows:

That it be and is hereby determined by said City Council that H Street, in said City, on both sides, between the East Line of Third Avenue and the West line Fourth Avenue, be improved between said points by the construction of cement concrete sidewalks and cement concrete curbs and cement concrete gutters thereon; all to be in accordance with the specifications for such work as contained in Ordinance No. 108, as amended, of said City.

The owners of property fronting on said streets between said points, shall have until the 18th day of November, 1928, within which time to construct such sidewalks, curbs and gutters thereon, at private contract. That the City Engineer be, and is hereby authorized and directed to give notice that said improvement has been decided upon and that property owners desiring to construct such sidewalks, curbs and gutters, by private contract, must complete said work on or before the 18th day of November, 1928.

All dirt and soil disturbed, chaged or removed in the carrying out of any part of said work is and shall continue to be the property of said City, and shall not be removed to any private property, or disposed of in any manner without the written consent of the City Engineer of said City.
