

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

No. 259

H Street

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, in the County of San Diego, State of California, that the public interest and convenience requires the following public work and improvement, to be done in said City, and therefore the City Council of said City, hereby declares its intention to order the following described public work and improvement in said City, to-wit:

The construction of portland cement concrete sidewalks, curbing and gutters on the northerly side of H street between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and a line 621.3 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue also portland cement concrete sidewalks, curbing and gutters in the return at the northwest corner of Fourth Avenue and H Street.

Also the construction of portland cement concrete sidewalks, curbing and gutters on the northerly side of H Street between a line 758.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and a line 958.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue.

Also the construction of portland cement concrete curbing and gutters on the southerly side of H street between a line 68.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and a line 143.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue.

Also the construction of portland cement concrete curbing and gutters on the southerly side of H Street between a line 368.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and a line 443.1 feet westerly from the westerly line of Fourth Avenue. Excepting therefrom any of said work already done to the official grade or to the satisfaction of the Street Superintendent on said H Street.

All of said work hereinbefore generally described shall be constructed in the manner, at the locations, within the limits, and of the dimensions as shown upon and according to the plans, drawings, typical cross sections, and specifications therefor contained in document 99 on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and copies of which are on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, heretofore approved and

adopted by the City Council of said City as the plans, drawings, typical cross-sections and specifications to be followed in making said improvement; and by this reference thereto all said plans, drawings, typical cross-sections and specifications are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

The said City Council hereby determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment of twenty-five dollars or more remaining unpaid after the full expiration of twenty days from the date of the warrant, to represent the expense of said work and improvement, said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the fifteenth day of the next November following their date and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January every year after the fifteenth day of the next November following their date until the whole is paid.

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, interest payable semi-annually by coupon on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said bonds shall be issued and the principal and the interest thereof shall be paid under and in pursuance of the "Improvement Act of 1911" and amendments thereto.

That the contemplated work and improvement hereinbefore mentioned is in the opinion of said City Council of more than local and ordinary public benefit and the expense of such work and improvement are made chargeable upon the district herein~~after~~ described and said City Council does hereby declare said district to be the district benefitted by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

Said district is described as follows, to-wit; All that real property in the said City of Chula Vista included within the exterior boundary lines of said district, as shown upon that certain plat No. 99 indicating the exterior boundary lines of such district, which plat approved by said City Council, is on file in the office of the City <sup>clerk and City</sup> Engineer of said City; excepting therefrom all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways,

Reference is hereby made to said plat for a particular description of such district.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on the 5th day of February at 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chamber of said City Council in the City Hall of said City, in the City of Chula Vista, State of California, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why said proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

That the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby directed to cause this resolution of intention to be published twice in the Chula Vista Star a weekly newspaper published and circulated generally in said City and hereby designated for that purpose by the said City Council, there being no daily news paper published in said City of Chula Vista.

That the Street Superintendent of said City shall after the adoption of this resolution of intention, cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of said contemplated work and improvement, at not more than three hundred feet in distance apart, but not less than three in all, notices of the passage of this resolution of intention, and when the work to be done is only upon an entire crossing or intersection, ~~or~~ any part thereof, he shall cause such notices to be conspicuously posted in front of each quarter block or irregular block liable to be assessed, and when work is chargeable upon a district, he shall cause such notices to be conspicuously posted <sup>along and the</sup> upon all <sup>and in front of all the property liable to be assessed,</sup> open streets within such district, at not more than three hundred feet in distance apart on each street so posted, all in the time form and manner required by law; and thereupon said Superintendent of Streets shall caused to be filed in the office of the City Clerk of said City, an affidavit showing the posting of said notices of improvement. The said City Council does not deem it advisable that the City Clerk of said City mail copies of the notice of improvement to owners or reputed owners, and he is not required to mail the same.

All of the herein proposed work shall be done in pursuance of an Act of the legislature of the State of California, designated as the "Improvement Act of 1911, approved April 7th, 1911, and amendments thereto.

Passed, adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1929, by the following vote, to-wit:
