

RESOLUTION NO. 262

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California:

That a fair proportion of the monies voted by this State for the establishment of State Public Parks should be expended therefor in Southern California:

That there are at least three sites in San Diego County that are unexcelled in all elements entitling it to such a Park and now being considered therefor:

That the authority authorized to locate such Parks are urgently requested to consider the advantages and merits of such sites:

That any of said sites which may be considered the most suitable for such purpose by the body empowered to select same is hereby approved and recommended by this Council.
