

RESOLUTION No. 267.

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, that it absolutely and fully endorses the project for a United States Army Air Depot in Chula Vista, California, and it will do whatever is necessary on its part to be done, toward completing the dredging therefor on the Chula Vista shore of San Diego Bay, to the amount of \$100,000.00, by calling a bond election therefor, and that it has, and hereby does authorize and instruct the City Attorney of said City, to at once commence proceedings for calling a special bond election to vote upon the question of issuing bonds for the above amount for the above purpose; and it will further use all of its authority to grant for said project, the tide lands as follows, /to-wit:/ In the East Half of Quarter Section 170 and Quarter Section 171, and those lying west of the central line of Quarter Section 171, and extending to the bulkhead line and extending 1000 feet north along said bulkhead line, such tide lands comprising approximately 192 acres.
