December 23, 1913

WHEREAS, five members of the National City Fire Department responded to the call for help from Chula Vista at the time of the burning of McCoy's Livery Barn, and came over to give aid at said fire; on the morning of November 28, 1913; now, therefore, be it resolved that we hereby appropriate out of the general fund the sum of ten dollars to be paid to George E. Miner, Chief Engineer of said Fire Department, to be paid by him to said five firemen for their said services, and that a warrant be drawn for the same. The resolution is on motion duly seconded, adopted; all voting aye.
