

RESOLUTION OF WITHDRAWAL FROM COUNTY FREE LIBRARY SYSTEM BY
~~OF~~ THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA.

Whereas, on April 4th, 1933, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista authorized the necessary legal steps for withdrawing from the County Free Library System, and a letter was written to the County Board of Supervisors of San Diego County by the City Clerk conveying to them the intention and desire of the City of Chula Vista to so withdraw from the said Free Library System of the County, and

Whereas, a legal notice was published in the Chula Vista Star on the 14th and the 21st days of April, 1933, said newspaper being published weekly, and designated by the City Council for this purpose, which newspaper circulates throughout the City of Chula Vista and surrounding territory, notifying the public of the contemplated action, giving therein the date, and the place of meeting at which such contemplated action was proposed to be taken, and

Whereas, at the time and place fixed in said notice, to-wit, at 7:30 P. M., Tuesday, May 2, 1933, the matter of such contemplated action was taken up and an opportunity given the public to be heard thereon, and

Whereas, it appearing advisable for the said City to withdraw from the said County Free Library System of the County of San Diego,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego shall be notified by the City Clerk that the said City of Chula Vista has hereby withdrawn from the said County Free Library System.
