RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULT OF SPECIAL ELECTION, No. 371.

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held and conducted in the City of Chula Vista, California, on Thursday, the 30th day of August, 1934,

AND WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished, and that in all respects said election was held and conducted, and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof, made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the general laws of the State, providing for and regulating municipal elections in cities of the sixth class,

AND WHEREAS, the said special election held as above set forth, was held for the purpose of the electors of the said City of Chula Vista to decide whether or not Councilman Claude V. Brown and Councilman William T. Lyons should be recalled as City Councilmen of the said city; also, for the purpose of deciding the method of procuring successors to the above mentioned councilmen, if the recall prevailed, whether by appointment of successors, or by an election to elect successors.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of said City of Chula Vista, California, met at the Council Chamber thereof, on the 4th day of September, 1934, to canvass the returns of said election; and

AND WHEREAS, the said Council finds as a result of said canvass that the number of votes cast, and other matters required by law, to be as hereinafter stated, now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED, determined and declared as follows:

That the said special election was held and conducted in the City of Chula Vista, California, on Thursday, the 30th day of August, 1934, in time, form and manner as required by law.

That there were two voting precincts established in said City, for the purpose of holding said election, as follows:

Consolidated Precinct "A", consisting of State and County Precincts Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 6, as established for holding State and County elections, and the polling place was the City Hall, in said City.

Consolidated Precinct "B", consisting of State and County Precincts Nos 4, 5, 7 and 8, established for holding State and County elections, and the polling place thereof was Perry's Garage, 233 Alvarado Street, in said City.

That the total number of ballots printed and furnished for this election was 2200.

That the whole number of votes cast in said City of Chula Vista, at said election was 1152.

That the names of the persons voted upon to be recalled as City Councilmen, the number of votes received for and against such recall by each of said persons, in said consolidated precincts, and the votes cast for the method of procuring successors for said Councilmen, if the recall prevailed, are as follows:

RESOLVED, THEREFORE, that at the said special election held in the City of Chula Vista, California, on Thursday, August 30, 1934, the recall of Councilman Claude V. Brown, and Councilman William T. Lyons, did not prevail, and the said Councilmen will retain their offices as City Councilmen of the said City of Chula Vista, California.
