

RESOLUTION No. 372.

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Mr. Oscar F. Weissgerber, having resigned the offices of City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets of the said City of Chula Vista, after having filled these positions for a period of three and one-half years in a most creditable manner, and

WHEREAS, this Council is of the opinion that the said Mr. Weissgerber, during his services with this City, has demonstrated unusual ability in the handling of men employed by him, in accomplishing good results with inadequate equipment, in his thorough knowledge of city engineering work, and that he has a thorough knowledge of the work of the two offices mentioned, combined with the vigor to keep operations in his departments moving and up-to-date at all times, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the said City Council of Chula Vista regrets exceedingly that conditions are such that it was necessary for this Council to accept Mr. Weissgerber's resignation from the two positions above mentioned; but that the said Council feels compensated in this loss by the knowledge that Mr. Weissgerber's resignation was accepted in order that he could enter into a better and more remunerative position.
