

RESOLUTION NO. 381.

WHEREAS, The City of Chula Vista has authorized Allen and Rowe, Civil Engineers, to file an application with the State Emergency Relief Administration for a project consisting of beautification of certain parkways by means of horticultural planting, and

WHEREAS, said State Emergency Relief Administration does require the City of Chula Vista to give full assurance, that if such project be approved, said planting will receive proper care and attention for a period of at least six months subsequent to the completion of said project, or until such time as said plants are firmly established,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, in meeting assembled, does hereby give full assurance to said State Emergency Relief Administration, that if such project be approved, the City of Chula Vista will care for and maintain said planting for a period of at least six months subsequent to the completion of the project, or, until such time as said plants are firmly established.
