SPECIAL ELECTION.

Resolution No. 383

WHEREAS, a protest against Ordinance of # 234 of the Ordinances of the City of Chula Vista California, was filed with the Clerk of City Council of said city on October 31, 1934, which protest has been found sufficient and

WHEREAS, said protest and the findings of said Clerk^{as} to the sufficiency thereof, the same having been found sufficient; has been this day, to wit, Wednesday November 7, 1934, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Chula Vista California, submitted to the City Council aforesaid, and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the City Council to submit to the electors of Chula Vista California said ordinance # 234 for their approval or rejection at the next general election or at a special election, as said City Council may decide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, that a special election be, and it is hereby called to be held in the City of Chula Vista California, on ~~Friday~~ ^{Tuesday} December ~~4~~ ¹¹, 1934, and the election officers to conduct the said Special Election are hereby designated and appointed as follows:

There is hereby established Consolidated Precinct "A", comprising State and County precincts numbers 1, 2, 3 and 6, for which the officers are:

Inspector: Florence E. Shadinger,

Judge : Ola M. Fuqua,

Clerks: : Maye G. Rice and Alice E. Streich.

The polling place for Consolidated Precinct "A" be and is at the City Hall, Chula Vista, California.

There is hereby established Consolidated Precinct "B", comprising State and County precincts numbers 4, 5, 7 and 8, for which the officers are:

Inspector: Ruth A. Kindberg,

Judge : Margy E. Weaver,

Clerks : Edith M. Tyler and Julia Rhodes.

The polling place for Consolidated Precinct "B" be and is at the Womens Club House 357 G. Street, Chula Vista California.

Each election officer aforementioned is an elector and resident of the consolidated voting precinct for which he or she is appointed. The compensation for each election officer is hereby fixed at Five Dollars (\$5.00) for his or her services in said election.
