

RESOLUTION No. 390

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT, TO-WIT, A RECREATION CENTER AND PARK CONSISTING OF THE PURCHASE OF A PARK SITE, THE LANDSCAPING AND IMPROVEMENT OF SAME, AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SWIMMING POOL AND BATHHOUSE, INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION OF NECESSARY EQUIPMENT.

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does resolve and determine as follows:

SECTION 1. That the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition and construction of a municipal improvement, to-wit, a recreation center and park consisting of the purchase of a park site, the landscaping and improvement of same, and the construction of a swimming pool and bathhouse, including the installation of necessary equipment. That the acquisition and construction of said municipal improvement is necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of said city. That the estimated cost of said municipal improvement is the sum of \$35,000.00, and that said estimated cost of said municipal improvement is and will be too great to be paid out of ordinary annual income and revenue of said city.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall cause the same to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of said City of Chula Vista and shall make an entry of the passage and adoption thereof in the minutes of said City Council

of said city at which the same is passed and adopted.
