Each election officer aforementioned is an elector and resident of the consolidated precinct for which she is appointed. The compensation for each election officer is hereby fixed at Five Dollars (\$5.00) for her services in said election.

The polls will be open from 7:00 o'clock, a. m., until 7:00 o'clock, p.m.
