

RESOLUTION NO. 444.

WHEREAS, the City of Chula Vista, California has heretofore, to-wit, on the 27th day of January, 1936, advanced the sum of One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,950.00) from its General Fund for the paving and improvement of Fifth Avenue as set forth in the second Paragraph of Resolution No. 442, of the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California; and

WHEREAS, said sum was expended in accordance with that certain Memorandum of Agreement dated the 24th day of January, 1936, made and entered into by and between the State of California, Division of Highways and the City of Chula Vista, California; and

WHEREAS, there is now deposited in the Special Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund of the City of Chula Vista, California the sum of \$ 1,637.86; that there will be deposited therein before the end of the current fiscal year a sum of not less than \$ 312.04, or a total of not less than \$1,950.00; and

WHEREAS, said sum of \$1,950.00 was so advanced from said General Fund for such Improvement with the understanding that said advance should be repaid to said General Fund; and whereas, such advance and plan of repayment was approved by the said Department of the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, as follows, to-wit:

That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to transfer to the General Fund of the City of Chula Vista, California an amount totalling \$1,950.00 from the first funds received by said Special Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund of the City from the State of California; said transfers to be made if, as and when such funds are so received.

PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, this 1st day of June, 1936, by the following vote, to-wit:
