Whereas, The Chula Vista Union Grammar School District is the owner of Lot 17 of Quarter Section 137 of Rancho de La Nasion, in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, and which property is located at the Southeast Corner of $2 d$ Avenue and E Street, in said City, and consists of 5 acres more or less; and

Whereas, the Boa rd of Trustees of said School District have indicated their willingiess to sell, subject to law, said property to the City of Chula Vista, California, for the purpose of a-play-ground and-recreation center for a sum approximating $\$ 2500$; and
