

RESOLUTION NO. 452.
PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING PURCHASE OF RECREATION
PARK

Whereas, the Chula Vista Union Grammar School District is the owner of Lot 17 of Quarter Section 137 of Rancho de la Nacion, in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, and which property is located at the Southeast corner of Second Avenue and E Street, in said City, and consists of 5 acres more or less; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of said School District have indicated their willingness to sell, subject to law, said property to the City of Chula Vista, California, for the purpose of a playground and recreation park for a sum of approximately \$2500.00; and

Whereas, the City Council of said City has not now on hand funds available for the purchase of said property; and

Whereas, said Council believes that the most practicable manner of acquiring said property would be by procuring funds therefor from the general taxes of said City of the fiscal year 1936-1937; and

Whereas, said Council believes that the matter of acquiring such property by said City with funds as aforesaid be done only upon approval of the electors of said City; and

Whereas, a special election to so decide can be economically held on the 25th day of August 1936 whereby the said electors of said City can express their approval or disapproval of such proposed purchase of said property;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, as follows, to wit:

First: That a Special Election be, and it is hereby called to be held in the City of Chula Vista, California, on Tuesday the 25th day of August 1936;

Second: That the proposition of said election be: Shall the City of Chula Vista, California, expend the sum of \$2500.00 for the acquisition from the Chula Vista Grammar School District of Lot 17 of Quarter Section 137 of Rancho de la Nacion, in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California, as a Playground and Recreation Park, said sum to be paid from the general tax for the fiscal year 1936-1937;

Third: That there shall be and there is hereby established eight (8) voting precincts for the purpose of holding said election consisting of the regular election precincts established for holding the State and County Elections on the 25th day of August 1936, and the polling places thereof shall be the same as for said State and County Election, as follows, to wit:

- (1) Precinct 1, the polling place for which shall be at the Township Court located at 119 National Avenue, in said City;
- (2) Precinct 2, the polling place for which shall be at 380 D Avenue, in said City;
- (3) Precinct 3, the polling place for which shall be at the City Hall, 294 Third Avenue, in said City;
- (4) Precinct 4, the polling place for which shall be at the Chula Vista Auto Court, 398 National Avenue, in said City;
- (5) Precinct 5, the polling place for which shall be at the Women's Club House, 355 G Street, in said City;
- (6) Precinct 6, the polling place for which shall be at Residence, 283 G Street, in said City;
- (7) Precinct 7, the polling place for which shall be at Residence, 225 J Street, in said City;
- (8) Precinct 8, the polling place for which shall be at Orchard Operating Company, 3d Avenue & K Street, in said City;

Sixth: /The polls will be open for such special election for and during the same hours of said State and County Election, to-wit from 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M.

Seventh: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice in accordance with the law of said special election in one issue of the Chula Vista Star, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Chula Vista, California, and to perform such other duties in connection with such special election as may be prescribed by law.
