RESOLUTION NO. 453

Final Resolution - Chula Vista Lighting Maintenance District 'A'

*Notice of*

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California did on the 15 day of July 1936 pass its Resolution of Intention No. 450 to order the hereinafter described work to be done and improvement to be made in said City, and which Resolution of Intention was duly and legally published as required by law as appears from the affidavit of L. L. Thompson, now on file in the office of the Clerk of said City; and

Whereas, Notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention No. 450, which Notices were titled "Notice of Local Improvement", were duly and legally posted along the line of said contemplated work and improvement and in front of all the property liable to be assessed therefor, and on and along each and every open street and highway in the assessment district described in said Resolution of Intention, in time, form, manner and number as required by law after the passage of said Resolution of Intention, as appears from the affidavit of Lynn Eove who personally posted the same, and who, upon the completion of the posting of said Notices forthwith filed said affidavit in the office of the Clerk of said City making oath that he completed the posting of said Notices on the 29 day of July 1936; and

Whereas, No protests or objections have been presented in the time, form and manner as required by law; and

Whereas, the said City Council has now acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

That the public interest and convenience require the work herein described and referred to;

That the said Council hereby orders the following work to be done and improvement to be made in said City, to wit: the furnishing of electricity to and the maintenance of an ornamental street lighting system as described in said Resolution of Intention, no alterations having been made;

That said district shall be known hereafter as "Chula Vista Lighting Maintenance District 'A'";

That the Report of the City Engineer of said City be and the same is hereby adopted as a whole;

That the said City Engineer having estimated the cost of such furnishing of electricity to and maintenance of said lighting district for the first fiscal year at Two Thousand Eighty-four and 64/100 Dollars (\$2,084.64), THAT seventy per cent (70%) of said estimated cost shall be levied upon the lands within said assessment district as before described and that thirty per cent (30%) shall be paid by said City from its lighting fund, and that all subsequent levies shall be upon said basis;

That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Assessor of the City of Chula Vista, California, and shall be his authority for levying said assessments, which are hereby ordered to be levied beginning with date of commencement of said improvement, heretofore fixed by the said City Council and ending with the close of the fiscal year following the current fiscal year, as provided by law;

That the said City Clerk is hereby directed to publish twice, a notice inviting sealed proposals or bids for the work and improvement hereby ordered, and referring to the plans, specifications, and official report on file; said publication to be made in the Chula Vista Star, a weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City and hereby designated for that purpose;

That all said proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the order of the City Clerk of the City of Chula Vista, California, and certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent (10%) of the aggregate of the proposal, as provided by law;

That said sealed proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of the City Council of said City on or before 7:00 o'clock P.M., of Monday the 7th day of September 1936, said time being not less than ten (10) days from the time of the first publication of the Notice of said work and inviting sealed proposals, and on which day and hour all proposals or bids will be publicly opened by said City Council.
