

APPROVING PROJECT STATEMENT FOR USE OF CERTAIN GAS TAX FUNDS ON STREETS OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE IN THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA.

FIRST, that that certain Project Statement No. One as set forth in Form MC-5 and addressed to the Director of Public Works of the State of California, Sacramento, California, dated August        1936, prepared and submitted to this body by Oscar F. Weissgerber as City Engineer, proposing an expenditure of \$2821.42 for the maintenance of shoulders alongside of strip pavements on streets of Major importance and specifically designated as follows;

E street from the east line of Third Ave to the west line of 5th. Ave.

J street from the east line of Third Ave to the west line of 6th. Ave.

Second Avenue from the north city limits to a point 660 feet south.

Third Ave from north line of Roosevelt street to north line of H street.

Fifth Ave from south line of F street to north line of J street.

such amount being a part of the One-quarter cent Gas Tax Fund allocated to the City for the 88th Fiscal Year, of the State of California (1936-37), be and the same is hereby approved;

SECOND, that G. H. Rife as Mayor of the said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute the said Project statement for and on behalf of said City;

THIRD, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the said executed Project Statement to E.E. Wallace, District Engineer, State Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, District XI, San Diego, California.
