

RESOLUTION NO. 461
ADVERTISING LETTING OF LIGHTING CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, California, did in open session on the 5th day of October, 1936 publicly open, examine and declare all sealed proposals or bids for doing the work and improvement in the said City described in Resolution of Intention No. 450 of the Resolutions of said City Council adopted the 15th day of July, 1936, which Resolution of Intention is hereby expressly referred to for a description of said work and improvement and for all particulars relative to the proceedings under said Resolution of Intention; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Consolidated Gas & Electric Company is the lowest and responsible bidder for doing said work and improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

That the Contract for said work and improvement will be made with the said San Diego Consolidated Gas & Electric Company;

That notice of such letting of said Contract shall be published in the Chula Vista Star, a weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City for two successive weeks immediately after the passage hereof;

That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby instructed to transmit proper notice thereof to the said newspaper in accordance with this Resolution.
