of Thompsons Subdivision, in the City of Chula Vista,
County of San Diego, State of California, according to the
map thereof, No. 1197, filed in the office of the Recorder
of said San Diego County, August 6, 1909; and

That that certain quitclaim deed dated Oct. 24 1936,
executed and delivered by J. Calvin Lauderbach and Maggie May
Lauderbach, as grantors, to the City of Chula Vista, California,
grantee, of the property described as follows, to-wit:

The Easterly Ten (10) feet of the Northerly Fifty (50) feet
of the Southerly One Hundred ninety five (195) feet of the
Easterly One Hundred twenty five (125) feet of Lot Seven
(7) in Quarter Section 137 of Chula Vista, in the City of
Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California,
according to the Map thereof No. 505, filed in the office
of the Recorder of said San Diego County, March 13, 1888; and

are, and each of them is, hereby approved and accepted by
the City Council of said City of Chula Vista, California, for and
on behalf of said City of Chula Vista, California:

That each and all of said property, is granted for street
purposes, and as a dedication thereof for such purposes, and as a
part of Third Avenue between Davidson Street on the South and
