

RESOLUTION NO. 471

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF A RECREATION CENTER AND PARK SITE, AND CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION THEREFOR.

The City Council of the City of Chula Vista does resolve and determine as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition of a recreation center and park site; that the acquisition of such recreation center and park site is necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of said City;

Section 2. That the land proposed to be acquired for said purposes is owned or controlled by the San Diego Trust & Savings Bank of San Diego, California, and is described as follows, to-wit:

All that real property situated in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, State of California as follows, to-wit: Lots 25 and 26 in Quarter Section 137 of Chula Vista, according to the Map of Chula Vista, ~~according to the Map of Chula Vista~~, a subdivision of a portion of the Rancho de la Nacion, No. 505, filed in the Office of the Recorder of said San Diego County, March 13, 1888; excepting from said Lot 26 so much as lies within the right of way of the San Diego & Arizona Railway, as granted by deed recorded in Book 789, page 25, of Deeds, in the Office of said Recorder.

Section 3. That said land can be acquired for the sum of \$5,500.00; that the sum of \$2,500.00 is now available from the general funds of the City to apply on such purchase price, subject to the approval of the qualified electors of said City; that the balance of the purchase price, to-wit: the sum of \$3,000.00 can be procured by including such sum in the budget for the fiscal year 1937-1938 and expending such sum from the general funds of said city for such fiscal year;

Section 4. That a Special Election be, and it is hereby called to be held in the City of Chula Vista, California, on Friday the 9th day of April, 1937;

Section 5. That the Proposition of said Election be:

SHALL THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA EXPEND THE SUM OF \$5,500.00 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A RECREATION CENTER AND PARK SITE OF NINE ACRES MORE OR LESS IN LOTS 25 and 26 IN QUARTER SECTION 137 IN SAID CITY, SAID \$5,500.00 TO BE PAID WITH \$2,500.00 APPROVED FOR PARK PURPOSES AT A SPECIAL ELECTION AUGUST 25, 1936, \$3,000.00 TO BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL TAX FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1937-1938.

Section 6. That there is hereby established two consolidated precincts for the purposes of holding said election, which precincts and the officers therefor shall be as follows:

Consolidated Precinct "A", comprising State and County precincts numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6:

The polling place for Consolidated Precinct "A" will be at
the City Hall, Chula Vista, California

For Consolidated Precinct "B", comprising State and County
precincts numbers 7 and 8:

Clerk: Mrs. J. A. King
Clerk: Lucille Creel

The polling place for Consolidated Precinct "B" will be at the
office of the Orchard Operating Company located at the North-
west Corner of 3rd Avenue and K Street in said City;

Each election officer aforementioned is an elector and
resident of the consolidated precinct for which he is appointed.
The compensation for each election officer is hereby fixed at
Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for his services in said election.

The polls will be open from 7:00 o'clock A. M. until 7:00
o'clock P. M.

Section 7. That a copy of this Resolution be sent to
each of the above named officers.

Section 8. That the City Clerk of said City is hereby
directed to publish notice in accordance with law of said
special election in one issue of the Chula Vista Star, a news-
paper published and of general circulation in the City of
Chula Vista, California, and to perform such other duties in
connection with such special election as may be prescribed by
law.
